## ARTICULATION APPROVAL

This approval is applied on the graduates of the Master of Physical Therapy (MPT) program and physical therapy post professional division at the University of St. Augustine (USA) for Health Sciences, St. Augustine, FL, on 2014 or before.

The Masters of Physical Therapy Program at USA at that time was accredited by the Distance Education and Training Council (DETC) and the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE).

The DETC is listed by the Department of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency and is approved by the Council on Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA). This national accreditation extended to the post professional advanced level program, and helped ensure that the MPT program has been carefully evaluated and has met nationally recognized standards of education.

### **Accreditations and Licensure Information**

**DETC** is currently listed by the U.S. Secretary of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency. DETC has held that status continuously since 1959, just seven years after the then U.S. Commissioner of Education began to fulfill a statutory requirement to periodically publish a list of nationally recognized accrediting agencies that the Commissioner/Secretary determines to be reliable authorities regarding the quality of the education or training provided by the institutions and/or programs they accredit. The current scope of the Secretary's recognition of DETC is the accreditation of postsecondary institutions in the United States that offer degree programs primarily by the distance education method up to and including the professional doctoral degree.

In order to be recognized by the Secretary, an accrediting agency must demonstrate to the Secretary's satisfaction that it meets the Criteria for Recognition, which are stated in Federal regulation. The Criteria do not differentiate between types of accrediting agencies, so the recognition granted to all types of accrediting agencies-regional, institutional, specialized, and programmatic-is identical. Only the specific scope of recognition varies according to the type of agency recognized.

**CAPTE** accredited the first professional Physical Therapy program at USA in October 1996 and reaccredited the program in April 2001. The University of St. Augustine for Health Sciences before 2014 was licensed to offer its degree programs by the State Board of Independent Colleges and Universities (SBICU), Florida Department of Education, Tallahassee, Florida. This licensure includes the Master of Physical Therapy (MPT), the Master of Occupational Therapy (MOT), the post professional advanced Master of Science in Physical Therapy (MScPT), and the Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT).
