

Proposed HPE 4 + 1 Bachelor's to Master of Art in Teaching

Eligibility

To be eligible for this program, the potential student should, by the end of the first semester of his/her junior year:

Have achieved a GPA of at least 3.0 overall Physical Education courses; and

Complete an application for pre-admissions to the EPP program (Interview, Essay,& References)

Have earned credit for (including courses received through placement or transfer) at least 75 hours of coursework applicable to the undergraduate BS in Physical Education - Teaching Concentration

First semester of junior year – meet with the HPE Program Coordinator before mid-semester to receive advising about the early-entry program.

Second semester of junior year – complete and submit early-entry application for graduate study in HPE MAT

Notification of acceptance will be made before the start of the senior year.

Senior year – enroll in MAT substitute courses.

At the end of senior year, successfully complete the requirements for a B.S. degree in Physical Education with at least 9 hours of MAT coursework which will be applied to the MAT degree program.
